- Monitors the status of the violation(s) during the "cure period."
- If necessary, handles billing of the owner for corrections made by or on behalf of the city.
- All parcels are maintained by asyst:Land Management and all data, such as violations and correction codes, are user definable.
- Easily scan and attach any types of files to the code enforcement database.
- Letters and notices can easily be created with Microsoft Word mail merge.
- All reports can be exported to Microsoft Word and Excel.
- Complaints can be downloaded from your organization's website with our optional jUSTInter.net interface.
